GOALS/OBJECTIVES/SCRIPTURE

Bible Text: Luke 24:13-35

Key/Memory Verse: Luke 24:30-31a

PURPOSE

General Objectives

- Locate the story in the Gospel of Luke
- Retell the Emmaus story
- Learn the memory verse

Specific Objectives

- Understand that Jesus revealed himself in breaking the bread and continues to be revealed in the sacrament of communion
- Identify the relationship between prophecies in the Hebrew Scripture and how God fulfilled them in Jesus' birth, life, ministry, death, and resurrection.
- Explore the idea of walking with Jesus and our continuing faith journey
- Explore the idea of recognizing Jesus: how do we "see" Jesus today in everyone we encounter?
- Explore the idea of welcoming strangers: how do we greet and share our Story with them?
- Explore the idea of supporting each other in mourning (times of grief) and celebration: how these disciples were transported from the depths of despair and fear to the ultimate revelation of eternal life because they supported each other and were able to welcome that stranger even in their grief
- Explore our response of evangelism: when our hearts burn within us, we must go and tell; we can do no other!
